Dr. Eva Gerharz is a Professor of Sociology of Globalization at Fulda University of Applied Sciences, Germany and holds a doctoral degree in Sociology from Bielefeld University. Since more than 20 years, she conducts research in and collaborates with partners from South Asia. Her book, *“The Politics of Reconstruction and Development in Sri Lanka- Transnational Commitments to Social Change”* (2014, Routledge) is the result of 12 months of empirical research in conflict-ridden Jaffna, Sri Lanka. In 2007, she worked as an Associate Scientist at the International Centre of Integrated Mountain Development (ICIMOD), Kathmandu. Her recent research interests include social movements in Bangladesh, particularly indigenous activism in the Chittagong Hill Tracts.
