IPRs and the International Transfer of Climate Change Mitigation Technologies

About the Lecture

The lecture opens a dialogue on the use of intellectual property rights (IPRs) in climate change mitigation technologies (CCMTs). IPRs play an ambiguous role determining technology transfer as strong IPRs can enable a market expansion effect but they may also strengthen monopoly power. Hence, the international transfer of CCMTs to developing countries has increasingly become a contentious policy issue. In this lecture, we look at the debates around the international transfer of CCMTs in the context of developing countries.
